Appointments can be set up by calling the office (865-689-1313) and speaking to Jason Napier. Our lunch break will be from 1 til 2 PM. Appointments will be set on a first come first served basis at five minute intervals. Families with two or more students will be grouped together.

You will find a price list on the second page of this letter. Photos will be mailed to your home within 3 to 4 weeks after your photo session. There is no sitting fee or shipping charge, and taxes are included in the prices. Payments are due the day portraits are made, and because we understand then costs of home schooling we are offering a 15% discount to family's with more than one student to be photographed. We guarantee your satisfaction by either remaking your child's portrait (retake and makeup dates to be set later), reprinting the order or refunding your money.

Thank you in advance for the opportunity to share in and capture these photographic memories of these most important moments in your children's lives.
