Teacher Training Workshops

Throughout the year Family Christian Academy schedules speakers who enhance your teaching with their presentations. These speakers are scheduled to speak at major cities. Annual FCA Family Camp

Join the fellowship and fun at Big Ridge State Park at our annual Camp Out. This camp is for the entire family. The camp will cost \$100/family for the week to rent a rustic 14'x16' cabin that sleeps eight in bunk beds. The dining hall, large kitchen, and two bathhouses will be shared. Each family will provide their own linens, personal items, food, sporting equipment, etc. Camp will have activities such as games, sports, hiking, shared dinners, swimming, devotionals as well as time for relaxing and fellowshiping. An FCA Family Group Camp application can be picked up at any of the three bookstores or downloaded from the website. A deposit of \$25 will hold a place for your family at camp; the deposit is not refundable after April 1, 2009.

Local Support Groups

FCA support groups are active in certain areas. If there is no FCA support group in your area we encourage you to consider starting or joining a local support group. Support groups generally share various parent/student talents and arrange for group field trips, crafts, teaching tips, etc.

Graduation

FCA commencement for Seniors is held each year at the Tennessee Theatre in June (Subject to change).

Testing

The Stanford Achievement Test is administered annually through FCA in the spring. Testing schedules will be available online at our website or by calling your local ARK Center after January 30. We also have diagnostic and career testing to help you evaluate your students.

PAR Plan

The Plan for Advanced Records is FCA East's newest plan. Under the PAR Plan a student submits their work weekly to the local ARK Center for scoring and record keeping. This plan works well for parents who have limited time or for parents who want to have someone other than themselves grading the student. Under this plan the parent must sign a PAR Agreement (found on page 24) and must pay a \$55 monthly fee for grading and record keeping.
